The Holiday Bazaar has all booths reserved with 25 of the 35 being paid for. The committee is attempting to obtain additional floor space to expand the Bazaar. Lance Hulse has donated 5 banners for advertising. Going Postal has donated 4000 flyers for advertising. Price Chopper has agreed to place flyers in grocery bags.

The Senior meeting went well with numerous fundraising ideas suggested. The Project Grad Committee is still seeking additional seniors to provide input at the monthly meetings.
