## HOW TO APPLY TO COLLEGES

- Call a college and **set up a College Visitation Day**. Forms are available in the Counseling Office so you will be counted absent. Two days per student are allowed, but **MUST** be used before the end of the third quarter.
- **Fill out and mail two or three college applications** by the end of October.

## **Scholarship Application Listings**

**UMKC Saturday Outreach Academy**—All students who are interested in pursuing a career in the medical field are eligible to apply for the UMKC Saturday Outreach Academy. Stop by the counseling center soon to pick up an application.

**American Legion Scholarship**—Seniors who have attended Missouri Boys State or Missouri Girls State conferences are eligible to apply for The American Legion scholarship. Applications can be picked up outside the counseling center.
